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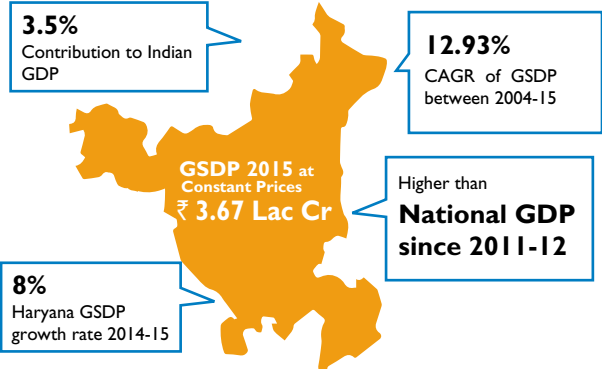

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## Haryana - Incentives & Subsidies Offered

### Tourism Policy 2008

#### Interest Free Subsidy

New projects with investment of ₹ 100 crore would be extended the facility of financial assistance to be quantified at 50% of the tax paid under the Haryana Value Added Tax Act 2003 for a period of 7 years, as Interest Free Loan (IFL) repayable after a period of 5 years from the date of grant of IFL.

New Small Projects with investment of ₹ 3 crore would be extended the facility in shape of IFL for period of 5 years

Exemption from Electricity Duty to the new tourism/hotel projects, for a period of 5 years

### Enterprises Promotion Policy- 2015

No CLU/NOC required in 31 blocks, while Automatic CLU in 75 blocks, 119 Services related to industrial activities under the Right to Service Act

Employment Generation Subsidy ₹ 36,000 per employee per annum for SC/Women

50% exemption towards External Development Charges

Investment Subsidy upto 75% of VAT/SGST net paid for first 7 years

Up to 100% refund on stamp duty



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
