

Udyam registration Process for MSMEs

All Entities/Enterprises falling in the revised definition given for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises by MSMED Act 2006, should file for Udyam Registration online on the Udyam Registration portal basis self-declaration.

The MSME Classification of an enterprise is based on both Investment and Turnover as follows:

| Classification | Investment in P&M or Equipment | Turnover |
|-----------------------|---|-------------------------|
| Micro Enterprise | Up to Rs. 1 Cr | Up to Rs. 5 Cr |
| Small Enterprise | > 1 Cr and upto 10 Cr | > 5 Cr and upto 50 Cr |
| Medium Enterprise | > 10 Cr and upto 50 Cr | > 50 Cr and upto 250 Cr |

Benefits of Udyam Registration:-**

- Udyam Registration number is required to avail benefits of all government schemes related to MSME
- Protection against delayed payments
- 50% discount on Trademark and Patent Fees
- ISO Certification charges reimbursement
- Waiver in security deposit while making application for Government tenders
- Ease of obtaining Registrations , Licenses and approvals

Procedure :

- Step 1: Go to <https://udyamregistration.gov.in/>
- Step 2: Fill your Aadhaar no, name as per aadhaar and click on “Validate & Generate OTP”
- Step 3: PAN Verification
- Step 4: Filling of Udyam registration form
- Post successful verification of Aadhar, Udyam Registration Certificate will be generated online.
- No fees is charged for applying Udyam registration.

Post registration process:

- A permanent registration number will be given after registration.
- After completion of the process of registration, a certificate will be issued online.
- This certificate will have a dynamic QR Code from which details about the enterprise can be accessed.
- There will be no need for renewal of Registration.
- A dedicated single window systems at Champions Control Rooms and at DICs has been created to assist in the registration process.
